12 ESSENTIAL FACTS

FOR UNDERSTANDING THE CURRENT ISRAEL-GAZA VIOLENCE

Israel and Gaza are not separate countries. Gaza is a small territory mostly surrounded by Israel and whose borders Israel controls (directly or in the case of one crossing, indirectly).

Gaza is often called an "open-air prison" -- for good reason.

Muslim, Christian, and Jewish
Palestinian Arabs peacefully shared
the land for centuries before Israel was
created.

Israel was founded in 1948 by forcing non-Jewish Palestinians off the land.

Israel has been taking over more Palestinian land ever since...

5 The two "sides" are not evenly matched.

Palestinians are killed at massively higher rates than Israelis, and this has always been true.

Palestinians in Gaza and the West Bank have often tried nonviolent resistance.

Numerous respected organizations have documented Israel's systemic human rights abuses and violations of international law.


10 Israel relies on funding and diplomatic cover from the U.S. Its actions often harm the United States

On Oct. 7, hundreds broke out of Gaza, attacked Israeli soldiers & civilians, and some took hostages. Israel disseminated atrocity claims about the attack, many of them found to be without evidence and untrue.

Israel immediately began indiscriminately shelling Gaza, killing and maiming massive numbers of men, women, and children.



THE COST OF U.S. SUPPORT FOR ISRAEL




In 2024, the U.S. provided Israel more than \$63 million in military aid per day, while it gave Palestinians \$3.2 million per day in foreign (non-military) aid.

NUMBER OF PEOPLE KILLED SINCE 2000

Since the start of the 2nd Palestinian Uprising on September 29, 2000 through July 31, 2025, **over 72,000 Palestinians** have been killed by Israelis while **less than 3,000 Israelis** were killed by Palestinians. These figures include **more than 21,000 Palestinian children** and **close to 200 Israeli children**.





In addition, the prestigious medical journal Lancet reported in July 2024 that as many as **186,000 Palestinians** may have died from Israel's attacks and its policies which have caused famine and disease in Gaza. More info at: iakn.org/Lancet
